Medical Mission Trip to Belize, Central America

Where: Belize, Central America, Orange Walk District Villages

Dates: Departure Sunday, December 1st through December 10th, 2024

Requirement to work in Belize: A temporary Belize license, updated healthcare license, diploma, police record, and updated passport. Nurses Belize temporary license fee is 15 US dollars.

Several airlines have daily flights to Belize. All volunteers are required to arrive at Belize International Airport (Philip Goldson) no later than 1:30 p.m. on December 1st, 2024 (if you need to take a later flight, please inform us ahead of time).

The hotel's information will be sent later. If it suits your preference, you can share a room to cut costs. For ground transportation, we ask for a donation fee of \$150.00 per person to help with the cost of the van's rental and gas. Gas in Belize as of today is 14 BZD a gallon. All your donations are tax deductible.

All healthcare workers are required to work in their scrubs and need to bring their own working tools for each clinic day.

Each day (Monday through Friday), we will travel to different villages. On Saturday, the 7th morning after breakfast, we will depart Orange Walk District and travel to the city to catch the boat to the island. There, you will have three free days to enjoy beautiful Belize before our departure. For those who need to depart Belize before the 7th please inform us in advance.

Volunteers needed are dentists, dental hygienists, nurses, nurse practicians, and ophthalmologists.
